DICK'S SPORTING GOODS BolderBOULDER RELEASES NEXT EDITION OF BOOTLEG MUSIC CD SERIES - WHAT STARTED WITH THE FRAY IS NOW UP TO VOLUME SIX

BOULDER, CO (April 27, 2009) – In the Spring of 2004, a little-known Denver band was one of the many entertainment acts to play curbside at the BolderBOULDER. They were The Fray and their song “Some Trust” also led off the first BolderBOULDER Bootlegs music compilation CD.

These days The Fray is playing to record-setting audiences and the Dick's Sporting Goods BolderBOULDER is getting ready for its 31st running on Memorial Day, Monday, May 25th. After last year's record-setting 54,000-plus entrants, this year's event will supply what might be the biggest audience ever for each of the more than 30 entertainment acts along the 10-kilometer course.

A wide range of entertainment will be heard with the solo acoustic sounds of **Susie Ransom Wood** and 18-year-old Arvada resident **Kita Hudson**, the funky groove of the **Holden Young Trio**, the up-tempo bluegrass sounds of **Missed The Boat**, the jazz of **ZARO**, the rock trio **Meniskus** and the brotherly folk of the **Kirkpatrick Project**, just to name a few! **Elvis**, the **Blues Brothers**, DJs spinning tunes and the 'all ages bands' at 20th & Pearl Streets will again be along for the ride! And don't miss **Wide Mouth Grin**, whose lead guitarist and songwriter is deaf. Yes, deaf.

It wouldn't be a BolderBOULDER without the belly dancers! **Beledi Dance Caravan** and the **Boulder Tribe** will again join **Ms. Tu-Tu's** enthusiastic dancing along the race route that starts at 30th & Iris and winds its way through the streets of Boulder ending at CU's Folsom Field.

As it's always been, this year's DICK'S Sporting Goods BolderBOULDER will be a community event as the **Boulder High School Pep Band** and **Boulder High School Pom Squad** again join various neighborhood bands along the route cheering and playing music at their locations.

For 2009, the BoulderBOULDER will be releasing **BolderBOULDER Bootlegs Vol. 6**, a CD of music from the bands playing along the course. A total of 13,000 copies will be given out *FREE* up and down the Front Range starting April 27. Mohammed is fresh from singing on **The Tonight Show with Jay Leno** as part of the "Playing For Change" tour. It's a free event and the hotel will have burgers, brats, beer, soda and water for sale on the outdoor deck.
