ABOUT US:

Every year team BOLDERBoulder works closely with the Boulder community to put on 2 special and unique road races, the BOLDERBoulder and the ColderBOLDER, that see a combined total of more than 52,000 runners, walkers, and joggers.

The Races

The BOLDERBoulder, named America's All-Time Best 10K by Runner's World and ranks as the third-largest race in the country and the largest 10K in the United States. Takes place on Memorial Day in beautiful Boulder, CO. Finishing at Folsom Field, this race is one for the bucket list and continues to amaze participants, spectators, and VoIRUNteers year after year.

The ColderBOLDER, our holiday invitational and open races, takes place in (sometimes) chilly December on the picturesque CU Boulder campus. This sold-out race encourages participants, friends, and family to celebrate a little cold sweat, the holidays and staying BOLD all year round.

ABOUT THE POSITION:

As America's All-Time Best 10K, executing the plans is key to the success of the race. From start to finish, our crew provide logistical support. As a member of the EXPO Crew, you will...

- Perform a variety of duties associated with the set-up, tear-down and smooth running of the Pearl Street Mall Pre-Race Expo and CU Campus Race Day Expo.
- Unload and load trucks with supplies for the Pre-Race and Race Day Expos.
- Move tables and chairs to and from Vendor Booth sites
- Assist with booth set-up for the BOLDERBoulder Retail Booth as well as set-up for other Vendors
- Assist with booth tear-down for the BOLDERBoulder Retail Booth as well as other Vendors
- Patrol an assigned block on the Pearl Street Mall to assist vendors with trash removal and answer vendor questions
- Other work in support of the success of the race as needed.

NUTS AND BOLTS:

The Expo crew report directly to our Senior Manager of Partnerships. This position is considered a non-exempt, hourly, part-time, seasonal position. Work is full-time beginning the Friday before the race and extending through race day, FRIDAY, May 22nd - MONDAY, May 25, 2026. The approximate number of work hours over this time is 35-40 hours total.

Some days will require working more than 8 hours per day. Race Day starts at 5:00 AM and continues for 10 to 12 hours. **Seasonal employees must work part of race week, race weekend and race day (May 22 - 25, 2026).**

Onsite work is done at our headquarters office/warehouse or at one of our venues in the City of Boulder/University of Colorado.

Wages start at \$16.85 per hour. As a seasonal position, benefits include.

- BOLDERBoulder Official Team Gear Kit including Specialty Gear and Nike Running Shoes
- Meals/Snacks – Provided race week, race weekend and race day

ADDITIONAL:

Hours of work for this position may vary based on work schedule. Must be able to sit, stand, bend at the waist, climb, stoop, kneel, crouch, reach, walk, push/pull, lift, talk, and hear with or without reasonable accommodation. Lifting (up to 50 lbs.) and carrying, bending, and reaching overhead may be required.
